Where is Avalon Sailing Club?

Avalon Sailing Club is located in the Old Wharf Reserve off Hudson Parade, Clareville, approximately 50 metres west of the intersection with Riverview Road.

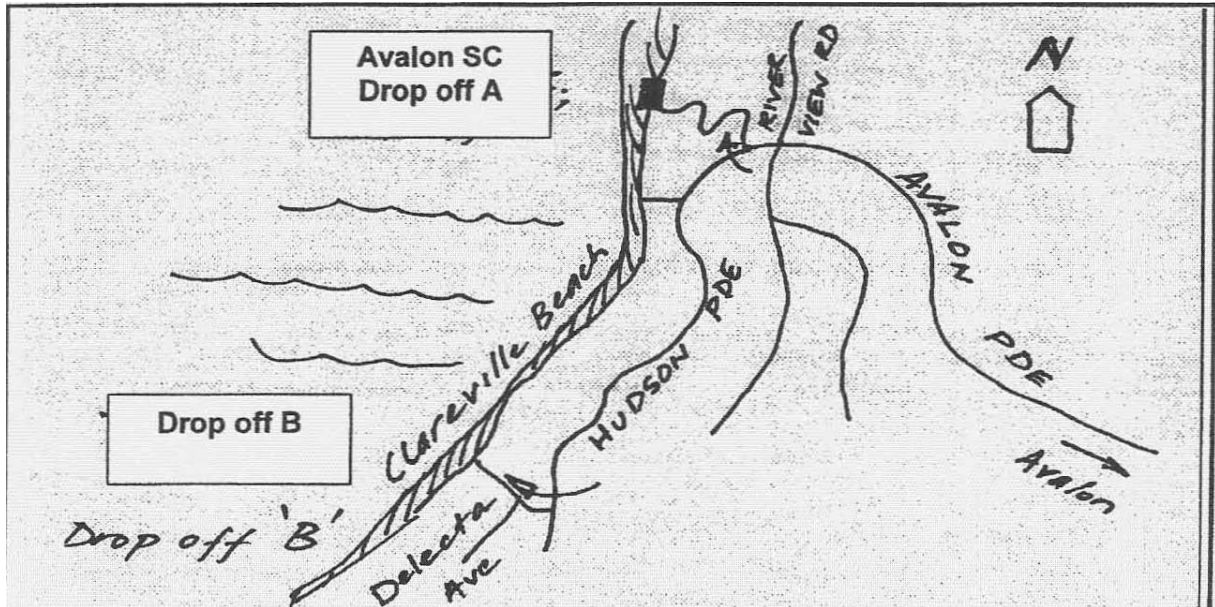

Facilities:

The club has a large timber rigging deck, canteen, clubroom, toilets and change-rooms. Parking and unloading is limited, so please expect to be asked to park in the surrounding streets.

Drop Off and Pick Up

Monday 28th from 0830 hrs -There will be an ASC Marshall at the entrance to Old Wharf Reserve to guide and direct visitors. Boats arriving on cars with roof racks may be unloaded at the club (Drop off A) and rigged on the deck. Boats arriving on trailers are to be unloaded at the public launching ramp in Delecta Ave (Drop off B), and towed around by tender shuttle to the rigging deck. An ASC Marshall will be on hand to direct unloading and parking.



Parking is available in Delecta Ave or the adjacent 'pay and display' parking area.

Please:

- Come prepared with some change for the meter, and
- Ensure access to private properties is respected at all times.

Boat Racks - Support teams will need to transport their boat racks to the club by car from Clareville Beach for between race and overnight storage. Please clearly label your rack for easy identification in a crowd.

Race briefings will be conducted in the upper level clubroom at ASC. Official notices will be posted on the upper level notice board at the club.

All competitors are expected to rig and keep their boat on the deck at the club for the duration of the series. Rigging space is limited so competitors are asked to follow direction from the deck marshals, keep access lanes clear and be tolerant and courteous to others needs.

To avoid traffic jams at launch time please let boats near the side deck lanes into the water first.

Competitors are asked to use the supplied water cans for washing down boats.

Sign on and sign off will be mandatory for all competitors each day.

Overnight Storage - Competitors may leave boats overnight on the deck but should take care to secure small items. The deck will be floodlit and gates locked.

Sunday Afternoon 3rd Jan. - A shuttle will operate back to Clareville after the race on Sunday.

Canteen

A caterer will be operating the canteen throughout the series, serving bread rolls, cakes, pies and sausage rolls and ice creams, soft drinks, juice and bottled water. It will be possible to place “lunch bag” orders for competitors each day.

Breakfast bacon & egg rolls will be available each morning.

Social Events

All participants friends and families are invited to a Welcome Dinner/BBQ at ASC on the evening of Mon 28th. Refreshments will also be available.

There will be a sausage sizzle each afternoon after racing when no other dinner event is happening.

The Trophy Presentation Dinner will be a BBQ buffet held at Mona Vale Surf Club at 1830 on Sun 3rd Jan. It is envisioned that competitors will be given enough time to pack up and load up trailers before the presentation. There is plenty of parking available at Mona Vale Surf Club.

Spectator Boats
